- Be in the know before you rule out options!

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Deep Dive - Let's Research!

With your mentee, follow the steps below to research their possible next steps:

Choose two careers, courses or apprenticeships to focus on

Explore different companies or universities that do these well.

What skills do you need to be accepted to these careers/courses?

Explore different pathways which can get you there.

Find different examples of people doing these jobs/courses and look at a day in their life.

Come up with a Plan A, Plan B, Plan C, & Plan D for both options – if something doesn't work out as planned, what will you do instead?
