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Interviews- What to Expect?

At an interview you'll discover if you want to work at that organisation as much as they are going to find out if you could work with them.

- Arrive early you can usually chill there beforehand and grab a drink before you go in.
- Be yourself stay calm (it's not a battle!), smile and make eye-contact.

Type of Interviews

Face to Face

- Before your interview, find out more about the job role and company
- Prepare some good stories relating to your CV.
- Print some copies of your CV to take in with you.
- Remember to dress for success, make eye contact and smile.

Phone

- You can have a cheat sheet in front of you throughout!
- Treat it like a face-to-face interview -- prepare your answers and practice saying them. Speak slowly and clearly.

Virtual

- Loungewear is a no-no!
- Find a quiet room with minimal noise and distractions.
- Sit up properly in a chair and (like any good selfie) you'll need good lighting!
